

Processes for Accreditation of Dietetics Education Programs

Dietitians Australia is the accrediting authority for dietetic education programs in Australia. Universities can apply for accreditation of their dietetic education programs.

This policy outlines what's involved in accrediting a dietetics program. It details:

- the processes for the accreditation application stages
- the Non-Domestic Placement Site Approval Process
- a decisions review procedure
- the rights of termination and withdrawal of an Accreditation Status
- timing and procedural requirements

Using the Processes for Accreditation policy

The Processes for Accreditation is separated into 7 sections.

Sections one to five

Gives an overview of the accreditation process, followed by an outline of each type of accreditation:

- Provisional Accreditation
- Full Accreditation
- Re-accreditation

Section six

Outlines the process for termination of the accreditation process and withdrawal of accreditation status.

Section seven

Sets out the decisions review procedures.

Terms of Reference

The Terms of Reference for Accreditation Reviewers and Accreditation Review Teams are included in appendix 2.
