You can expect your dietitian to:



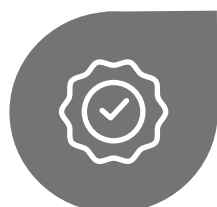
Demonstrate integrity

- ▶ Act with honesty and accountability
- ▶ Be open and transparent
- ▶ Uphold the reputation and trust of the dietetics profession



Practise respectfully

- ▶ Treat everyone with kindness, dignity and respect
- ▶ Value diversity and inclusion
- ▶ Listen to your needs and work in partnership with you
- ▶ Provide culturally safe care



Behave lawfully

- ▶ Follow Australian laws and regulations
- ▶ Maintain the privacy and confidentiality of your information
- ▶ Respect intellectual property and copyright



Practise safely

- ▶ Provide care that is based on the latest scientific evidence
- ▶ Recognise and manage risks to your health and wellbeing
- ▶ Deliver services within the recognised role of a dietitian



Practise ethically

- ▶ Make decisions in your best interests
- ▶ Declare and manage conflicts of interest
- ▶ Promote and protect public trust in dietitians
