WAIVING OF MOBILE FEES FOR ACCREDITED PRACTISING DIETITIANS

Firstly, I wish to congratulate you on supporting frontline health workers by waiving post-paid mobile fees upon identifying as registered with the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA). This will certainly provide additional support for those health professionals who have increased usage of mobile devices while navigating telehealth or staying in contact with family while undertaking extended shifts.

The Dietitians Association of Australia is the regulatory body for Accredited Practising Dietitians. Dietitians are not eligible to be registered with AHPRA. Accredited Practising Dietitians are an essential part of the health workforce supporting Australians in this challenging time. We ask you to consider extending this fee waiver to Accredited Practising Dietitians who are registered with the Dietitians Association of Australia on submission of their DAA membership number.

We would welcome the opportunity to work with you in setting up this arrangement to support all frontline health professionals with the inclusion of Accredited Practising Dietitians.
